General: Collection and use of personal data of customers, suppliers and other contractors.

We would like you to take notice of the fact that we gather and will use all personal data you supply us with, as we need it to conclude and execute any business agreements between TAKS and yourself. This applies to both (potential) customers and to parties from whom we purchase goods and / or services.

Being a (potential) customer of TAKS Handling System BV means that we will use your data to send you a quotation, to determine the specifications or wishes a specific item or service has to comply with, to deliver goods, to be able to carry out work for you, to invoice and to communicate smoothly and efficiently about implementation aspects of our agreement with you.

Being a (potential) supplier or other contractor of TAKS Handling Systems means that we also need your personal details for the conclusion and execution of the agreement. They're essential in the purchasing process, so we can let you know to which specifications or wishes a particular item or service should comply in our opinion. But also for sending a request for quotation or placing an order, for paying your invoices and for communicating fast and efficiently about other aspects of the agreement with you.

You are not obliged to provide us with your personal data. But if you provide us with insufficient or no personal data, there's the possibility that we won't be able to perform the aforementioned activities.

Disclosure

In relation to the execution of a possible agreement or contract with you, it might be necessary to provide other parties with your personal data. This includes parties who supply parts, materials or products to us or who we have assigned to carry out certain activities. We also make use of Microsoft Office applications and related external storage facilities for emails and other files.

Direct marketing

When we're given digital permission to do so by you, we will store and use the personal data you have provided in order to personally email you in the future with information on both existing and new products and services and possible promotions. Every time you're sent an offer by email, you're also given the opportunity to opt out of receiving future emails by clicking the unsubscribe link at the bottom of the email.

Website

TAKS Handling Systems B.V. uses only technical and functional cookies on its website as well as analytical cookies that do not infringe on your privacy. A cookie is a small text file that's stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone when you first visit one of our websites. The cookies used are necessary to guarantee the correct technical operation of the website and its user-friendliness. They also remember preferences you have set. The data of the cookies help us to optimise our website. You can disable the automatic storage of cookies by changing the settings of your internet browser. In addition, you can delete all information that was previously saved through the settings of your browser.

Conditions applicable to child's consent and processing of special categories of personal data

Neither our website or services intend to collect information about persons under the age of 16, unless consent is given or authorised by the holder of parental responsibility over the child. However, we can't check if a person visiting our website is over 16. We encourage parents to be involved in the online activities of their child, in order to prevent data being collected without parental consent. Should you be convinced that we have collected personal information about a person under the age of 16 without this permission, we urge you to contact us so that we can delete this data.

Data retention period

When becoming a customer of, or supplier or contactor to TAKS Handling Systems, the personal data provided by you will be retained for a period of seven years after closing the financial year in which the agreement we had with you has been fully executed. This seven-year period matches the obligatory administrative period set by the Dutch Tax Authorities. After this period, we will delete your personal data.

If you're a potential customer or supplier, we will save your name, address, telephone number and email address in order to contact you, should this be relevant to either party.

Your rights

You have the right to make a request to access, view, edit and change the personal data we've collected. If there's reason to do so, you can also make a request to add details to your personal data or change inaccuracies. You also have the right to make a request for the erasure of personal data or to limit the use of your personal data. You can object to the collection and use of your data or file a complaint with the Dutch Data Protection Authority. You have the right to receive the personal data concerning you and have the right to transmit those data to another controller.
